Mission Statement

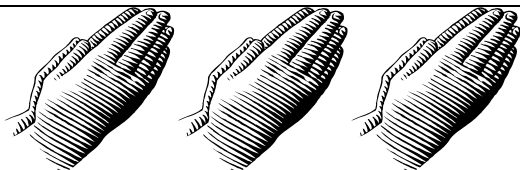

Tuesday, May 4th at 12:00 pm.

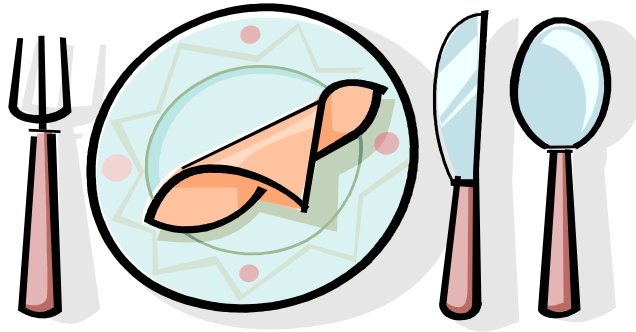
